SEXUAL HARASSMENT), SEXUAL ORIENTATION,  
MARITAL STATUS, PARTNERSHIP STATUS,  
ALIENAGE OR CITIZENSHIP STATUS, LAWFUL  
OCCUPATION, LAWFUL SOURCE OF INCOME, OR  
BECAUSE CHILDREN MAY BE RESIDING WITH YOU.
