TLC LICENSING FACILITY TO REOPEN

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that its Licensing facility, located at 32-02 Queens Boulevard, will reopen after a one day closure due to the possibility of an illegal transit strike. In addition, the TLC Adjudication facility, also at 32-02 Queens Boulevard, will reopen only for guilty pleas and Motions to Vacate.

For the purpose of hearings, the TLC Adjudication facility will remain closed for a minimum of one additional day, as will the Office of Judgment Enforcement.

As originally announced in Emergency Industry Notice #03, the Woodside Safety and Emissions facility will remain closed for regularly scheduled inspections (Hack Site will remain operational) until further notice.

The closure of these facilities is due to the continued redeployment of TLC personnel to key contingency plan-related functions. The TLC will communicate further status updates as they become available.
