NEW YORK MARRIOTT FINANCIAL CENTER HOTEL IS OPEN FOR BUSINESS

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) is pleased to announce that the New York Marriott Financial Center Hotel, located at 85 West Street (between Carlisle and Albany Streets) is once again open for business and welcoming taxicab service. In the past, there was a taxi stand at this location, which has been closed since the September 11th tragedy, but has now re-opened for business.

A coffee stand will be available in front of the hotel beginning Thursday, January 10, 2002 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. The hotel will additionally make restroom facilities available to drivers (drivers may park in front of the hotel while accessing restroom facilities).

Vehicular access to the hotel will be allowed through the NYPD checkpoint south of the Battery Tunnel entrance on West Street. The best routes to reach downtown are via the FDR Highway or Broadway southbound.
