NATURALIZATION REQUIREMENTS:

- You have resided in the United States as a permanent resident for five years (three if you are married to and living with a U.S. citizen).
- You have been physically present in the United States for half of the five, or three, year period.
- You are at least 18 years old.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- Your permanent resident card (green card).
- All passports since becoming a permanent resident.
- Home addresses and employment history for the past five years.
- Children's addresses, dates of birth, and A#s.
- Marriage and divorce history.
- Selective Service information, if applicable.
- Information about arrests, if applicable.

Please note:

The USCIS requires a \$675 filing fee, which includes a fingerprinting fee. It is not necessary to bring the fee (check or money order) to this event.
